HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR VIDEO

1

Create Your Video

Create a video between 2-3 minutes in length promoting Career and Technical Education and your organization. Use the suggested topics above as a starting point, but be innovative and creative in your approach!

Upload Your Video

Upload your video to YouTube or Vimeo, or you can upload the file to Dropbox or Google Drive. Ensure your link is available for public viewing, and submit your video link with your entry.

3

Complete Video Contest Online Entry Form

Submit your entry online at oregonctso.org/videocontest. The deadline for submission is Tuesday, October 18.

VIDEO CHALLENGE DETAILS

- This contest is open to students enrolled in any secondary CTE course/program or members of Career and Technical Student Organizations (CTSOs) in Oregon.
- There is no limit to the number of entries from each program/school.
- Entries may be submitted as teams or individuals. Entry teams must consist of students all from the same school.
- Submission will be accepted on a rolling basis, with final entries due by Tuesday, October 18.
- All videos become the property of the Oregon CTE Student Leadership Foundation and may be used for publicity/promotion purposes. Credit will be given to video creators.
- Every video submission will receive feedback from a panel of industry judges.
